For Specialty Camps, I understand the applicant will be participating in the aforementioned activities and other activities specific to the Specialty Camps: trips away from camp, wilderness overnight camping and interacting with dogs. I understand the risks associated with these activities and release 4-H Camp Whitewood, and the directors, trustees, officers, volunteers and employees of 4-H Camp Whitewood, from all liability for damages or injuries resulting from negligence or defects. I grant permission for the applicant to participate in all camp activities.

I hereby grant 4-H Camp Whitewood and its agents full authority to take whatever actions they deem necessary regarding the campers' health and safety, and I fully release 4-H Camp Whitewood from any liability in connection there within. In the event of an emergency, I understand that prudent attempts will be made to contact the undersigned immediately. In addition, I give permission to the medical personnel selected by the camp director to provide routine health care; to administer medications; to order X-rays, routine tests, treatment; to release any records necessary for insurance purposes; and to provide or arrange necessary related transportation for my child. In the event I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp director to secure and administer treatment, including hospitalization, for the person named above. I understand that the employees and volunteers of Northeastern Ohio 4-H Camps, Inc. (4-H Camp Whitewood), Ohio State University Extension (OSUE), The Ohio State University and Ohio 4-H are not responsible in the event of accidental injury or illness, nor for the compounded injury or illness to the participant's present medical conditions. 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# Camper Rules

<b>Please read, discuss and sign these rules with your camper.</b>			
<p>These rules have been designed to ensure the safety of the campers and to provide an emotionally safe and welcoming environment at camp. Each camp session may have additional rules but the following rules will be enforced at all camp sessions.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Always follow the direction of a counselor or staff member. Campers should always check with their counselor or staff member before leaving the group or area.</li> <li>2. Campers will not destroy or deface camp property. This includes graffiti.</li> <li>3. Always respect the wildlife (plants, animals, insects, etc.) at 4-H Camp Whitewood.</li> <li>4. Follow all posted signs, procedures and rules.</li> <li>5. Cell phones, iPods, video games and other electronic devices are not allowed at camp. Cameras are allowed, except in restrooms.</li> <li>6. Campers will show respect to others:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. No bullying or violence. Every camper is unique and important at camp.</li> <li>b. No obscene language. Be aware of how your words may affect someone else.</li> <li>c. No offensive music.</li> <li>d. Wear tasteful clothing. Avoid immodest clothes or offensive graphics/print.</li> <li>e. Respect the belongings of others. We don't touch something without asking.</li> </ol> </li> <li>7. The following items will not be permitted at camp:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Drugs, alcohol and tobacco,</li> <li>b. Weapons (guns, knives, etc.),</li> <li>c. Animals (EXCEPT K9 campers who have met the requirements to bring a dog),</li> <li>d. Personal sports equipment (archery, firearms, baseball equipment, etc.).</li> </ol> </li> <li>8. If the camper is 16 or older AND has a valid driver's license, the camper may drive him/herself to camp ONLY if all paperwork and signatures have been completed in advance by the parent. Car keys will be turned in upon arrival and secured until the last day of camp for the camper.</li> </ol> <p>If a camper does not follow one or more of these rules the parent may be called and the camper may be sent home; no refund will be issued. Camp staff reserve the right to search camper belongings for prohibited items when reasonable suspicion is confirmed. If prohibited items are found, they may be confiscated.</p>
